POLICE REPORT

Between the 10th January and the 10th February, the following crimes and incidents were reported to the police.:

10/01/20 Vehicle with no tax stopped on Bosworth Rd

28/01/20 Abandoned vehicle on Main Street,

03/02/20 Theft from motor vehicle Bosworth Rd,

03/02/20 Burglary on Bosworth Rd, still under investigation.

Please utilise the 101 reporting line for *anything* you believe to be a concern, so that we can collate accurate information for the parish to help our PCSO to target any themes.

At the February meeting, our PCSO shared with us the increase of number plate thefts to facilitate criminals with both domestic and petrol forecourt burglaries.

In response to this, Coalville Tyre & Exhaust Centre are offering free fitting of tamper-proof screws to help in the community. If you want to take advantage of this offer, they are located on 206 Central Road, Hugglescote, Coalville, Leics LE67 2FG

Please be vigilant and make use of our free resource, the “**Community Safety Box**” (details on the parish website) as a deterrent for burglaries to premises, and commercial vehicles. You can come to the next meeting on the 23rd March to collect any items you may find useful.

PARISH PRIORITIES

Thank you to everyone to completed a parish survey as it allowed the Councillors to shape the priorities and spend for 2020. The parish council plan to spend parish funds on the following priorities:

SID (Speed Indication Device)

To invest in our own mobile traffic calming device allows us to have the autonomy to move the warning sign to the trouble spots in the parish.

Snarestone in Bloom project

Through securing a grant via our district council, we can now enhance the look of the village with more areas to house plants, flowers to further instil pride in our parish.

Replace Fire Door on the Pavilion

For the overall safety to all users, and offer confidence to any external parties hiring the pavilion.

Christmas Tree lights and decorations

The parish council would like to create an attractive focus for Christmas 2020 by investing in external lights and better outside decoration to make Snarestone a village to remember driving through this year!

Petanque Court on the Conery

It was recognised that it would be beneficial for the Conery area to be able to offer recreation for those in the parish other than younger children on the pay area. We plan to create a petanque court area, and who knows... maybe enter into the local petanque league for those who want to?!

Path to the pavilion on the Conery

To ease access to the pavilion, it was suggested to create a clear, robust and user-friendly path up to the pavilion area.
